Please let me encourage to you to read the 20th chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, beginning at verse 7.

There are two sides to this Baptism: the first is, that you possess the Spirit; the second is that the Spirit possesses you. Financial Stewardship of the Church By Rev. Charles Willner

The Lord Gives Us the Power to Get Wealth:

The foundation of any teaching on financial stewardship is to remember that it is the Lord our God who gives us power to get wealth.

"But you shall remember the Lord your God: for it is he that gives you power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he swore unto your fathers, as it is this day." (Deuteronomy 8:17,18)

Tithing Superseded and Came Before the Law:

Tithing goes back to righteous Abraham. Abraham gave tithes to Melchizedek when he returned from battle. So, Melchizedek blessed Abraham. (Genesis "And as you go, preach, saying, The kingdom of 14:18-20) In Hebrews 7:5-8, we read that the father of faith, Abraham, gave tithes to Melchizedec. This shows that tithing comes before the Levitical priesthood. (vs. 11)

Tithing Brings the Blessing of God:

When we rob God of the tithe, we force God to close the windows of heaven so that He cannot bless us.

"Bring you all the tithes into the storehouse, ... and prove me now herewith, says the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough The Law of Sowing and Reaping: to receive it. And I will rebuke the devourer for your "Be not deceived, God is not mocked for whatsoevsakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; ... and all nations shall call blessed." (Malachi 3:10-12)

This may be the only Scripture that instructs us to "And whatsoever you do, do it heartily, as to the challenge God, "prove me now herewith, says the Lord of hosts." So, we have the power to get the Lord to work for us to get provision for our needs. If we give our tithes, the Lord who owns the cattle on Right in the middle of Paul's mission letter to raise a thousand hills is duty-bound to meet our needs.

Tithes were to be Used to Help the Levites (the Priests) the Poor and the Widows:

From the Old Testament, tithes were used to help the destitute in Israel.

"At the end of three years you shalt bring forth all by giving us, his creation, the riches the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shall that he had with lay it up within your gates: And the Levite, (because the Father in he has no part nor inheritance with you,) and the heaven stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which before are within your gates, shall come, and shall eat and he be satisfied; that the Lord your God may bless you in came. the work of your hand which do." (Deuteronomy 14:28,29)

There is much said in the New Testament about how the Church was to care for their widows. "There arose a murmuring of the Grecians against the Hebrews, because their widows were neglected in the daily ministration." (Acts 6:1) "Let not a widow be taken into the number under (sixty) years old, having been the wife of one man. Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work." (1 Timothy 5:9)

"For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that you through his poverty might be Those Who Obtain Their Living from Giving Must First rich." (2 Corinthians 8:9)

The Ministry Is to Take Charge of Giving:

In the New Testament Church, offerings to help the needy were laid at the apostle's feet.

"And laid them down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need." (Acts 4:35)

Paul asked that collections be received on the first day of each week for the missionary needs of the saints in Jerusalem.

"Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God has prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come." (1 Corinthians 16:1,21

Tithing Is the Means of Support for the Ministry:

When tithes are not received for the support for the ministry, that ministry is forced to return to their secular life in order to support themselves and their families.

"For the Levites and the singers, that did the work, were fled every one to his field." (Nehemiah 13:10)

Paul said that an elder is worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in the word and doctrine.

"For the scripture says, You shall not muzzle the ox that treads out the corn. And, the laborer is worthy of his reward." (1 Timothy 5:17,18)

Through several examples of; soldiers, farmers, and oxen, Paul lays down the principle that the ministry is to be supported by those who receive the gospel from that ministry. In fact, he claims divine authority for this principle from "the Lord". (1 Corinthians 9:6-14)

However, even as the apostle Paul confessed, "Yes, you yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me. (Acts 20:34) Many of us have had do secular work in order to support ourselves in the ministry. But that lack of funds does not excuse us from giving

(and from our secular work) to those over us in the ministry.

Be Examples:

While those in the ministry expect their church members to give their tithes and offerings to the ministry, quite often those same ministers do not give tithes and offerings themselves. But ministers should be examples to their people to be generous in their giving to the church.

"The husbandman that labors must be first partaker of the fruits.' (2 Timothy 2:6)

The Tithe of the Tithe:

"Thus speak unto the Levites, and say unto them, When you take of the children of Israel the tithes which I have given you from them for your inheritance, then you shall offer up an heave offering of it

> for the Lord, even a tenth part of the tithes." (Numbers 18:26)

> "And the priest the son of Aaron shall be with the Levites, when the Levites take tithes, and the Levites shall bring up the tithe of the tithe unto the house of our God, to the chambers, into the treasure house. ... and we will not forsake the house of our God." (Nehemiah 10:37-39)

> Here we see an important principle: even those who live from the ministry are also to pay tithes to those in au-

thority over them. The Levites were to be supported in their ministry by the tithes of the people. Yet, they themselves were also to pay tithes to the house of God. So when a minister gives his tithes, he cannot put those tithes back into his own ministry: they must be given to another ministry. This is true even when a minister does not receive enough remuneration from his ministry, and he has to work at secular work to support his family.

Giving Is the Support for Missions:

Paul writes a powerful plea letter, in 2 Corinthians chapters 8 and 9, urging that the Corinthians to prepare an offering to be taken to the saints at Jerusalem, just as those in Macedonia had so generously done.







Hit 6. Shut Up

We are almost done! We have hit that battleship 5 times, and only 2 more to go. That battleship is going down. Hit #5 was talk, talk, talk. And #6 is shut up. What is going on?

That gift of God needs to flow and have movement. But there is a place so precious, so tender, so careful a gift that God has shared with you, and that is the place of silence. It is a tender shoot of a plant, a seed that has sprouted and needs such care. I have held dreams for years and never told a soul, and one day it was a strong tree, and I started telling people. It was so grounded in my life that others could not crush it.

When we have a dream or God gives us a vision, we get excited, and want to tell others. Maybe our friend, maybe our spouse, our parent or co-worker. There are people who live to crush your little plant life, not because they necessarily hate you, but because it is just what they do. Why are you "special"? Do not share with them. Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus,

The last few months have been very busy here in Durban. March 28th we welcomed our daughter, Eliana Jabulile. She weighed 2.9kgs and is healthy and strong. She is a blessing to our family.

We have also been very busy with some community development projects that we planned for the year. The first one was a parenting workshop which we hosted. We invited parents and caregivers of vulnerable children and presented them with information to help them in their roles. We brought in the local school principal, social workers and community caregivers from the local clinic who were able to answer questions and assist the families. Our next workshop will be in August, and



we will be doing an HIV awareness campaign in the community. All of these outreaches are used to make connections with the community and open doors for ministering in their lives.

This month, we also started our first orphan home! We have assisted children and families in various ways, but this is the first time we are providing a home and caregiver in a longer term basis. We now have three orphans living at our center under the care of our orphan care coordinator. We have dreamed of doing this from the time we came to South Africa, and are thankful that we can have this impact!! We also have an additional 80 children in our orphans and vulnerable children program that we are assisting with school uniforms as well as food parcels.

We continue to expand our ministry to the widows and disabled. We have a wonderful lady who does home visits and assists them with their various needs. We have also recently started a reading and writing class for the elderly. We have 3 of the grannies attending, as well as one of our orphans who was not able to learn in a traditional school setting. They are all doing really well, and we enjoy seeing them learn!!

We are thankful to God for the opportunity to minister in Durban, South Africa. We are using every opportunity to preach the gospel and share God's love. **Thank-you** to all those who are supporting our ministry through prayer and finances. Missions Report

Report from Kell Frandsen - Grace Life Ministries

We have now completed 3 years here in India. It has been hard plus also an incredible adventure. Our churches are growing with our pastors ministering in some still dangerous situations. The reception to the gospel has been very great whenever we have had the chance to preach, there has also been great openness to see healing and miracles in all the meetings we have done.



The richest harvest fields are the tribal areas with 33% have become Christian, next is the huge slums in India an incredible challenge amidst the misery found there.

I have become close friends with Rev Dr. Pattniak who oversees as part of the presbytery of AOG North India 1334 churches his brother in law also has another 800 churches both in 4 North India states. I recently held a week conference for several hundred of these leaders and pastors it was a wonderful time.

We have visited the fields some were there are great numbers of villages where there is not one single Christian. Our main work is ministry in the slums and rescue of at risk children providing homes and education for them. When I was in Thailand 3 years ago I was informed through a leader that has masters in studies of peoples that this year 2015 there will be 2 billion living in the slums of the world. India has the largest slum in the world in Bombay made famous by the movie "Slumdog Millionaire".

Christianity was brought to India 2000 years ago by the apostle Thomas yet India has only 3-6% Christians. This is massive field with over 1.24 billion Indians, but Christ has given us the mandate plus the authority of Jesus Christ to take this nation. I believe though it is a mission for the whole body of Christ to pray to give to go.

There are well proved strategies God is showing the church here to solidly expand His kingdom. I would like to share what we have learned plus what some of the major players here have taught us through the great work they have done.

In Joshua Chapter 1 God tells Joshua as he prepares to enter Canaan that he is entering his rest ie taking the Promised Land. I believe that the church taking Canada and other nations is her destiny and in that she will rest in who she was meant to be, mighty in God!
