Dear Servant of the Lord:

CONQUERING DISCOURAGEMENT

1 Kings 19:1–15

Text: 1 Kings 19:14

“And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: because the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away.”

“I quit. I’m fed up. I can’t take any more. Nobody seems to care.” These are often the words that that discouraged utter in sadness or anger. But not all of the discouraged speak of their discouragement; they just reveal it silently in their lifestyle.

Discouragement is found in schools, in governments, in offices, in homes, in factories and even in churches. Anywhere you find people, you will also find discouragement. From the beginning of time, it has been one of Satan’s chief and most effective weapons to use against the people of God.

1 Kings 19 encourages us to conquer our discouragement.

The life of Elijah reveals three things we must do to conquer discouragement.

1. RECOGNIZE THE CAUSES OF DISCOURAGEMENT.

God, in his inspired Word, reveals the causes of Elijah’s discouragement. These causes are the same ones we face today. James said, “Elijah was a human being, even as we are.” James 5:17 NIV.

A. THE PHYSICAL CAUSES.

Under a juniper tree in the wilderness south of Beersheba, Elijah asked to die. Only twenty-four hours earlier he had seen God’s power revealed, the false prophets of Baal slain, the nation of Israel on the verge of repentance, and the much-needed rain welcomed. But now he was facing hunger and exhaustion, and he was discouraged.



B. THE SPIRITUAL CAUSES. Sometimes physical causes are obviously not the only causes for discouragement.

1. The loss of spiritual perspective. When Elijah requested to die, was he not saying,

“Lord, I have lost my spiritual perspective”? This loss resulted in a feeling – “Lord, I’m not appreciated” – and an overactive imagination that said, “They seek my life,” when it was not “they” but only Jezebel. In this condition, it is easy to say, “No one likes me and everyone is against me.”

2. The loss of spiritual freshness. The picture of Elijah on his knees praying for rain had changed. He was no longer spiritually fresh. Fear had replaced faith. Spiritual freshness had become spiritual stagnation.

2. UNDERSTAND THE CONSEQUENCES.

If you want to conquer discouragement, you must do more than just recognize the causes; you must understand the consequences.

- A. A forsaken purpose. Israel was a nation headed back to God. A revival was at hand. The people were crying, “the Lord, he is the God; the Lord, he is the God.” 1 Kings 18:39. But God’s man was kilometers away under a juniper tree praying to die. Because of discouragement, he had forsaken God’s purpose for his life.



- B. Negative thinking. Three hundred kilometers south of the place of victory, the discouraged man of God became a negative thinker. Consequently, he visualized himself as the only true follower of the Lord God left in the world. The words of Elijah reveal the depths of his thoughts. The writer of Proverbs said, “for as he thinketh in his heart, so is he.” Proverbs 23:7.

3. ACCEPT THE CURE.

Even in the midst of Elijah’s discouragements, God was at work trying to get him to accept his cure. He allows discouragement to come, but he always has an effective cure that he wants us to accept.

- A. God’s care. Although God did not approve of Elijah’s state of mind, he continued to tenderly reach out to his servant. The food, the rest, and the shelter were wonderful evidences of the loving Father’s continuing care. How different the outcome might have been had it not been for him who cares for the discouraged.
- B. God’s companionship. Elijah could command his private servant to remain behind, but he could not escape the companionship of the Lord. The writer of Psalm 139 said:
7 “Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?

8 If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. 9 If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea;

- 10 Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.*
- 11 If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me.*
- 12 Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee.”*

The still small voice of God speaks of continuing companionship.

C. God's commission. God offered a cure to Elijah's troubled soul by saying, "Go back the way you came, and go to the Desert of Damascus. When you get there, anoint Hazael king over Aram. Also, anoint Jehu son of Nimshi king over Israel, and anoint Elisha son of Shaphat from Abel Mehalah to succeed you as prophet."
1 Kings 9: 15, 16

Discouragement can be conquered, and you can do it.
You do not need to resign; you simply need to be reassigned.
God is willing for that to happen. Are you?

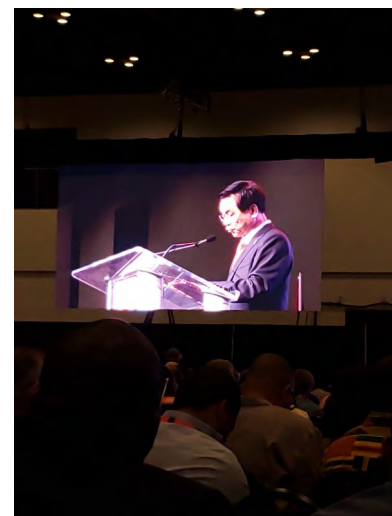

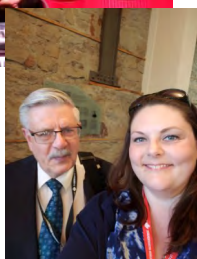

Report from The 25th Pentecostal World Conference in Calgary AB

The 25th Pentecostal World Conference in Calgary AB was exciting, powerful, and a privilege to attend. Our own General Secretary, Rev Paul McPhail, spoke in one of the daytime sessions and was very clear, anointed, and ‘knocked it out of the park’. We are so blessed to have him leading us in this ministry.

Over 4500 persons were in attendance with 74 countries represented. To worship, exalt our King and pray together in bold tongues was magnificent. Wednesday night, was a night of forgiveness and restoration while denominations apologized for the past, solemnizing that around the table of Holy Communion. In the closing meeting Friday night, we agreed with a commissioning prayer to do the work of the gospel while holding hands throughout the auditorium.

The many difference speakers from around the world, challenged us in many ways but specifically in these three areas:

1. following the Holy Spirit and praying in other tongues
2. preaching from the Bible and encouraging a higher literacy of the Bible in all believers
3. evangelizing the nations

Forgiveness is an act of wisdom. Let us walk well advised in it!

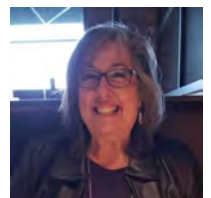

We are delighted to be able to bring you great news again from our ministry. Our mandate is to serve God and serve those who pray, sponsor, and are part of this ministry. In 1994, 25 years ago, God called me to India. He simply said as a friend, "Kell, will you come here for me?"

I was sick, scared, and seriously intimidated by India and realizing the cost this would make to our family. But God is able to raise us above our fears. After several more visits crunch time came. In 2017 we sold our house, gave away our business and our vehicles, and went on our incredible God-adventure. Jesus promises that in this lifetime those who give up anything in life for Him and His kingdom will receive a hundred times return in this lifetime along with persecutions Mark 10:29. We have certainly experienced incredibly hard times but God has also blessed a hundred fold over and over again. I can truthfully say we have seen incredible miracles and always God's faithfulness. We feel so privileged to be in this God-adventure.

I have been requested to write a book about my 45 year adventure with God. I have started and appreciate your prayers to finish this book for this is really His story of His faithfulness.

Since 2000 we have started at least 60 churches and ministered to many hundreds of children. We have set well over 10,000 free from poverty and brought irrigation and clean drinking water to over 100,000. A great number have come to Christ in the great city of Visakhapatnam as we worked in the slums. Hundreds of children have been educated, and we have many attending college and university. At present we are working with very well-known child specialists and arranging for a team to train our workers in the daycares so we have the best care possible and also so we can multiply this part of the ministry to bless many more children. We are really just starting!

We are in the midst of a major move for our main ministry centre and would appreciate your prayers for this. We have developed many ministry materials through books my wife Lorri has written - see www.gracelifeministries.info to view some books. I am presently working with a major AOG pastor in setting up practical Bible training for wonderful young people that we have chosen from Odisha. They will become pastors and evangelists to take in the huge harvest in our focus

district in Odisha. God has brought new friends plus new opportunities to expand the support base to strengthen our works in India. Our hearts are burning for Nepal as well. We feel though very responsible to make sure the ministry is fully accountable plus safe to bring western workers. We realize this will not just be us but will involve other partners for this to be a strong successful ministry.

Since last writing, India has gone through National and state elections. At the centre elected is an anti Christian government. Yet in Andhra Pradesh we have seen the biggest political upset in India's history. We have a Christian chief minister who won by 154 seats out of 171 seats a huge miracle! Why? Because the church was united and prayed. In Canada, our families, our freedoms, our ministries, and churches are under huge attacks.
